

CAAC Operations Specifications

F101. Permission for the transport of dangerous goods by air

HQ Control: 11/23/06
HQ Revision: 001

This paragraph certifies the foreign air carrier is permitted to conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air in accordance with relevant requirements of CCAR-276, ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284) and other governmental legal and regulations subject to the following conditions:

- a. All dangerous goods are to be carried in aircraft in accordance with the provisions of the CCAR-276 and the current edition of the ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284);
- c. The air carrier may carry the following categories of dangerous goods by air:

Class 1-Explosives;

Class 2-Gases;

Class 3-Flammable Liquids;

Class 4-Flammable Solids; Substances Liable to Spontaneous Combustion; Substances Which, in Contact with Water, Emit Flammable Gases;

Class 5-Oxidizing Substances and Organic Peroxide;

Class 6-Toxic and Infectious Substances;

Class 7-Radioactive Material;

Class 8-Corrosives;

Class 9-Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods.

- c. The foreign air carrier may conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air at the following airports:

- d. The activities of air transport of dangerous goods conducted by the foreign air carrier and its ground handling agents are subject to inspection by CAAC inspectors.
- e. This permission, unless waived, suspended, or revoked, shall be expired by **June 30, 2010.**
- f. Other special requirements, when applied:
The foreign air carrier may NOT transport any dangerous goods by air at Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport, except DRY ICE (UN 1845).
