**F101. Permission for the transport of dangerous goods by air****HQ Control: 11/20/04****HQ Revision: 000**

This paragraph certifies the foreign air carrier is permitted to conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air in accordance with relevant requirements of CCAR- 276, ICAO Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284) and other applicable laws subject to the following conditions:

- a. All dangerous goods are to be carried in aircraft in accordance with the provisions of CCAR- 276 and ICAO Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284);
- b. The air carrier can carry the following categories of dangerous goods by air:
  - Class 1 – Explosives
  - Class 2 – Gases
  - Class 3 – Flammable Liquids
  - Class 4 – Flammable Solids; Substances Liable to Spontaneous Combustion; Substances Which, in Contact With Water, Emit Flammable Gases
  - Class 5 – Oxidizing Substances and Organic Peroxides
  - Class 6 – Toxic and Infectious Substances
  - Class 7 – Radioactive Materials
  - Class 8 – Corrosives
  - Class 9 – Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods
- c. The operator can conduct the transport of dangerous by air at the following airport:
