F101. Permission for the transport of dangerous goods by air **HQ Control: 11/20/04**
HQ Revision: 000

This certifies the operator is permitted to conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air in accordance with relevant requirements of CCAR-276, ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air and other applicable laws to the following conditions:

a. All dangerous goods are to be carried in aircraft in accordance with the provisions of CCAR-276 and ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air;

b. The air carrier may carry the following categories of dangerous goods by air:

Class 1-Explosives;

Class 2-Gases;

Class 3-Flammable Liquids;

Class 4-Flammable Solids; Substances Liable to Spontaneous Combustion; Substances Which, in Contact with Water, Emit Flammable Gases;

Class 5-Oxidizing Substances and Organic Peroxide;

Class 6-Toxic and Infectious Substances;

Class 7-Radioactive Material;

Class 8-Corrosives;

Class 9-Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods.

c. The foreign air carrier may conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air at the following airports:

d. The regular activities of the dangerous goods transport conducted by the operator and its ground handling agents are subject to inspection by CAAC inspectors;

e. Other restrictions and requirements:

1) Asiana Airlines must ensure that all staff (including agents) involved in dangerous goods transport have been sufficiently trained in accordance with the requirements of CCAR-276 and ICAO Technical Instructions.

2) Asiana Airlines can only conduct dangerous goods transport by cargo aircraft at Guangzhou Baiyun International Airport;

3) Asiana Airline can handle outbound dangerous goods of class 2,3,9 and inbound dangerous goods except class 1,7 at Tianjin Binhai International Airport.

f. This permission, unless waived, suspended, or revoked, shall be expired by Feb. 28th, 2011.
