F101. Permission for the transport of dangerous goods by air

This paragraph certifies the foreign air carrier is permitted to conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air in accordance with relevant requirements of CCAR-276, ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284) and other governmental legal and regulations subject to the following conditions:

a. All dangerous goods are to be carried in aircraft in accordance with the provisions of the CCAR-276 and the current edition of the ICAO Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284);

b. The air carrier may carry the following categories of dangerous goods by air:

Class 1-Explosives;

Class 2-Gases;

Class 3-Flammable Liquids;

Class 4-Flammable Solids; Substances Liable to Spontaneous Combustion; Substances Which, in Contact with Water, Emit Flammable Gases;

Class 5-Oxidizing Substances and Organic Peroxide;

Class 6-Toxic and Infectious Substances;

Class 7-Radioactive Material;

Class 8-Corrosives;

Class 9-Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods.

c. The foreign air carrier may conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air at the following airports:
