**F101. Permission for the transport of dangerous goods by air****HQ Control: 11/20/04****HQ Revision: 000**

This paragraph certifies the foreign air carrier is permitted to conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air in accordance with relevant requirement of CCAR Part 276, ICAO Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284) and other governmental legal and regulations subject to the following conditions:

- a. All dangerous goods are to be carried in aircraft in accordance with the provision of the CCAR Part 276 and the current edition of the ICAO Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284);
- b. The air carrier can carry the following categories of dangerous goods by air:
  - Class 1-Explosives: Division 1.3, Division 1.4.
  - Class 2-Gases: Division 2.1, Division 2.2.
  - Class 3-Flammable Liquids
  - Class 4-Flammable Solids; Substances Liable to Spontaneous Combustion; Substances Which, in Contact with Water, Emit Flammable Gases: Division 4.1, Division 4.2, Division 4.3.
  - Class 5-Oxidizing Substances and Organic Peroxides: Division 5.1, Division 5.2.
  - Class 6-Toxic and Infectious Substances: Division 6.1, Division 6.2.
  - Class 7-Radioactive Material
  - Class 8-Corrosives
  - Class 9-Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods
- c. The operator can conduct the transport of dangerous by air at the following airport:

- d. The activities of air transport of dangerous goods conducted by the operator and its ground handling agents are subject to inspection by CAAC inspectors.
- e. Other restrictions and requirements:
  - (1) Federal Express Corporation must ensure all staff (including agents) involved in dangerous goods transportation have been sufficiently trained in accordance with the requirements of CCAR-276 and ICAO Technical Instructions.
  - (2) Federal Express Corporation must strictly comply with the safety procedure made by itself during conducting outbound dangerous goods transport in China.
- f. This permission, unless waived, suspended, or revoked, shall be expired to **Oct. 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010**.
