This paragraph certifies the foreign air carrier is permitted to conduct the transport of dangerous goods by air in accordance with relevant requirements of CCAR- 276, ICAO Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284) and other applicable laws subject to the following conditions:

- a. All dangerous goods are to be carried in aircraft in accordance with the provisions of the CCAR-276 and ICAO Technical Instruction for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air (Doc. 9284);
- b. The air carrier can carry the following categories of dangerous goods by air:

Class1-Explosives

Class2-Gases

Class3-Flammable Liquids

Class4-Flammable Solids; Substances Liable to Spontaneous Combustion;
Substances Which, in Contact with Water, Emit Flammable Gases

Class5- Oxidizing Substances and Organic Peroxides

Class6-Toxic and Infectious Substances

Class7-Radioactive Material

Class8- Corrosives

Class9-Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods

- d. The activities of air transport of dangerous goods conducted by the operator and its ground handling agents are subject to inspection by CAAC inspectors.
- e. Other restrictions and requirements:
- (1) All Nippon Airways can handle outbound dangerous goods of class 2,3,9 and inbound dangerous goods except class 7 at Tianjin Binhai International Airport.
 - (2) All Nippon Airways must ensure all staff (including agents) involved in dangerous goods transport have been sufficiently trained in accordance with the requirements of CCAR-276 and ICAO Technical Instructions.
- f. This permission, unless waived, suspended, or revoked, shall be valid until **May 31st, 2012.**
